### SITE AUDIT MODULE

### Generates reports with best practice recommendations

- > www.drupal.org/project/site\_audit
- > Requires drush (executed via command line)
- > Outputs reports in plain text, HTML, and JSON
- > Integrates with a few other modules



## **EXAMPLE EXECUTION**

> drush @music aa --html --bootstrap > /my/destination/music.html
